Piano Lessons

- The WunderKeys method books are designed to be used in a 30 or 45 minute lesson setting.
- Students begin in Primer
 Piano Book One and work
 through Primer Book Two and
 Primer Book Three.
- On average, it takes a child a "school year" to fully complete the program.
- Graduates of WunderKeys Primer Book Three move into WunderKeys Level 1.

THE PROGRAM

- WunderKeys Primer method books are designed to provide young beginners with a solid grounding in beginning piano skills including keyboard awareness, note reading, and rhythmic understanding.

A PARENT'S ROLE IN HOME PIANO TIME How to practice the piano with WinderKeys Primer Books

- Read the comic pages to your child.
- Follow the instructions provided to complete the "off-the-bench" activities and the "on-the-page" activities.
- Review these pages daily with your child to solidify the new concepts being taught.
- Read the instructions to your child and complete each task.
- Have your child clap the rhythms of the practice pieces and name the notes (after Book 1, Lesson 3)
- Complete the guided score-study activities.
- Assist your child in playing the three, short practice pieces provided.





- Have your child clap and count the rhythms.
- Have your child point to and name the notes.
- Help your child to find his or her starting position. This information is provided at the top of each page as a "keyboard picture" or as "Finger Number Clues" (Books 2 and 3).
- Move & Groove pages are also included in Books 2 and 3 to assist with moving "out of position".



- WunderKeys Primer books contain frequent "cut and play" games with instructions provided on the back of each game board.
- You will need dice and some coins or buttons to play the games at home with your child.
- Children love repetition.
 Play the games often to allow your child to experience repeated success.



- Revisit completed lesson modules frequently.
- Have your child practice the short musical excerpts on previously-completed Pathway Pages as "warm up" activities.
- Have your child play previously-completed pieces from the music pages while paying close attention to posture and hand position, rhythm, dynamics etc.
